Christos Anesti! Christ is Risen! It is with great joy that I write to you this blessed month of June. All of us gathered together during this past Holy Week, we worshiped together, and we celebrated the Resurrection of Our Lord. On Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup> we will celebrate the Holy Ascension of Our Lord. Ten days later, on Sunday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, we celebrate Holy Pentecost. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, Chapter 2:1-4 we read:

"When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.
